ACKNOWLEDGEMENT of NIH FUNDING IS A REQUIREMENT

The Dartmouth Health Center for Rural Healthcare Delivery Science is a supported Center of Biomedical Research Excellence (COBRE) program through the National Institute of General Medical Sciences (NIGMS). NIGMS requires that we acknowledge COBRE support in books, articles, abstracts and presentations that have resulted from the award either directly or indirectly through the use of COBRE resources such as Research Cores.

2. Link the publication from PubMed to NIH grant P20GM148278
3. Submit the manuscript to the [NIHMS](#) immediately upon acceptance for inclusion in PubMed Central.
