ACKNOWLEDGEMENT of NIH FUNDING IS A REQUIREMENT

The Dartmouth Health Center for Rural Health Care Delivery Science is a supported Center of Biomedical Research Excellence (COBRE) program through the National Institute of General Medical Sciences (NIGMS). NIGMS requires that we acknowledge COBRE support in books, articles, abstracts and presentations that have resulted directly from the award including the use of Research Cores.

You should be citing the Dartmouth Health Center for Rural Health Care Delivery Science in your research under the following circumstances:

- The work of COBRE-funded research project leader (RPL) or pilot project leader (PPL) project is directly related to the topic of their specific COBRE project
- Any work that is supported by COBRE-funded resources, including Core resources and personnel

PUBLIC ACCESS IS A REQUIREMENT

In addition, the NIH requires that all journal articles resulting from the award funding be made freely available in PubMed Central (PMC) and linked to the award.

HOW DO I CITE THE COBRE AND COMPLY WITH NIH PUBLIC ACCESS POLICY?

1. Acknowledge support in each publication on which you are an author using the applicable statement below:

The content is solely the responsibility of the authors and does not necessarily represent the official views of the National Institutes of Health.”



2. Link the publication from PubMed to NIH grant *P20GM148278*
3. Submit the manuscript to the [NIHMS](#) immediately upon acceptance for inclusion in PubMed Central.
