

Voting in Vermont

1. Are you eligible to vote?

- a. 18 or older
- b. U.S. citizen
- c. Resident of Vermont
 - » Have taken the Vermont Voter's Oath

2. Do you have proof of eligibility?

- a. Valid photo ID (driver's license or passport)
- b. Current utility bill
- c. Current bank statement
- d. Another government document containing your residential address

3. How do I register to vote?

- a. By visiting your city or town clerk's office and completing a voter registration form.
- b. You may also register to vote at the polls on election day
- c. Using Online Voter Registration System: **Voter Information System**
 - » While there is no deadline to register to vote, to ensure your name appears on checklist, register on-line by the Friday before the election
- d. Registering to vote resource: **Voter Registration**

4. Where do I register:

- a. Guide to Vermont's Town Clerks, Treasurers & County Clerks:

5. Can I vote absentee?

- a. You may request an early absentee voter ballot by phone, in person at your local clerk's office, or in writing
 - » You do not need a special reason

6. How do I vote absentee?

- a. Complete paper form in person at city or town clerk's office
- b. Complete request for early absentee voter ballot form and mail, fax, or email to local clerk's office: **Early & Absentee Voting | Secretary of State**
 - » For the November general election, your ballot is automatically mailed to you if you are an active registered voter
 - » All early voter absentee ballot requests must be submitted by 5 p.m. or by the close of the town clerk's office on the day before the election
- c. Track absentee ballot here: **Voter Information System**



7. Vote

- a. All ballots must be received by the town clerk's office before 7 p.m. on the day of the election in order to be counted
- b. In-person on **November 3**
